#### **RESOLUTION NO. 419**

WHEREAS, Van Buren County is in need of funding for a project(s) that meets all of the requirements of Tennessee Public Chapter No. 651, Title III-22, items 10.33-34, and,

**WHEREAS,** Van Buren County is requesting \$100,000 for a project in the spending category of Covid-19 and,

**WHEREAS,** Van Buren County is requesting \$194,706 for a project in the spending category of Public Safety and,

**WHEREAS,** Van Buren County is requesting \$250,000 for a project in the spending category of Capital Maintenance.

**WHEREAS,** it is agreed that this County will comply with the Terms of Agreement prescribed by the State Department of Finance and Administration, and,

**WHEREAS,** Van Buren County hereby authorizes the County Mayor to submit the application to the State Department of Finance and Administration, requesting approval to proceed with this project, and,

**WHEREAS,** it will be necessary to budget a total of \$544,706 in additional funds in the County General fund, and,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Local Legislative body of Van Buren County requests the State Department of Finance and Administration for initial approval of this project to Fund Van Buren County in accordance with the provisions of Tennessee Public Chapter No. 651, Title III-22, items 10.33-34. A list of expenditures included in this project on behalf of this County and is attached.
