Commissioner Mickey Robinson led us in prayer. We pledge Allegiance to the Flag led by Shawn Perez.

Approval of Minutes from the July 20, 2021 Meeting.

Mickey Robinson made a motion, second by Bill Mosley to approve the minutes from the July 20, 2021 Meeting. All approved by voice vote. Motion passed.

Tax Rate Resolution

The Tax Levy Resolution was passed June 29, 2021 but the verbiage needs to be corrected. William Maxwell made a motion, second by David Chandler to approve the Tax Rate Resolution to exceed the Certified Tax Rate.

Levy a Tax Rate in Excess of the Certified Tax Rate Resolution # 469

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-1701 (a), requires that, in the event of a general reappraisal in a county, the county legislative body shall determine and certify a tax rate which will provide the same ad valorem revenue for that jurisdiction as was levied during the previous year; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-1701 (b), authorizes the State Board of Equalization to establish policies providing a procedure or formula for calculating the certified tax rate and Van Buren County followed that procedure after reappraisal in 2021 and,

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-1702, authorizes a county legislative body to exceed the certified tax rate set according to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-51701, by resolution after advertising its intent to exceed the certified tax rate in a newspaper of general circulation in the county (with an affidavit of publication sent within thirty days after publication to the State Board of Equalization) and public hearing; and

WHEREAS, Van Buren County desires to levy a tax rate in excess of the certified tax rate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Van Buren County Legislative Body, meeting in regular session on this the 17th day of August 2021, that:

Section 1. A tax rate, in excess of the certified tax rate, is hereby levied as follows: Certified Tax Rate of 2.3992 to 2.40.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the county legislative body.

Mayor Greg Wilson had sent each Commissioner a letter asking if Priority Waste is not ready to close on the BDS Property by October 1, 2021 he would like for this bid to be rejected and sent back to Committee B for a discussion of what to do next. If the Commission votes to do this he will then notify Priority Waste as soon as possible. A Citizens from Van Buren County Laura Wallace ask to speak. She mention that this has been going on with Priority Waste much too long, waiting on them to decide to buy the property or not and why is the Commission wasting so much time on them to purchase, when the County could have listed the property again. The County had voted to sell the Commercial property to Priority Waste at \$200,000.000 which she thinks was a discounted price with it being valued at \$300,000.000. Ms. Wallace explained, "In other words they have two week us to death." Commissioner Seamons stated, "That's why we are going with this deadline because it's time to move on." Commissioner Maxwell spoke saying, "When the Commission decided on selling the property, 1st time it was voted on to bid out to a Commercial Reality Agent with no bids that came in. 2nd time it was voted on by the Full Commission to bid the property out with only one bid coming in which was Priority Waste at the amount of \$200,000.000 and the bid was excepted." Commission Mosley thought it would benefit the County because it would bring jobs to the County through Priority Waste. With much discussion on this matter, Bill Mosley made a motion, second by William Maxwell to approve the Mayor to send a letter to Priority Waste with a deadline of October 1, 2021, with no action from them this matter would go back to Committee B.
