# Van Buren County Solid Waste Department Uncollectible Accounts Write-Off Policy and Procedures

#### BACKGROUND:

Van Buren County has various non-tax accounts receivable resulting from operations. Some of these receivables become uncollectible after a period of time, or an event.

#### **PURPOSE:**

To establish uniform guidelines for determining which delinquent accounts receivable should be considered a bad debt and written off. Also, to provide a fair representation of accounts receivable balances in the County's Financial Statements.

#### **POLICIES:**

Accounts receivable will be maintained in the County's Financial Statements for three calendar years from the Invoice date or date the last payment was received, whichever is later. After 90 days, the Van Buren County Attorney will attempt to collect.

An account will be written off, only after one or more of the following have occurred:

- Receivables have been listed Uncollectible due to the person being deceased.
- The Citizen is going through a hardship.
- Approval for ALL write-offs of individual accounts is REQUIRED to be approved by the County Commission.

#### PROCEDURES:

The Solid Waste Director shall prepare and review and Aged Trial Balance of accounts receivable at year-end to determine if delinquent receivables meet the

requirements set forth herein, to be written off a bad debt. A report will be prepared and submitted for approval(s). At a minimum, the following information will be included in the write-off request:

- 1. Name
- 2. Invoice Date
- 3. Amount
- 4. Invoice Number
- 5. Type of service rendered

#### PAYMENT RECEVED AFTER WRITE-OFF:

Any payment received on an account that has been written off will be recorded as revenue for Solid Waste in the period in which it is received.

#### 2026 BCBST Renewal, County Employee's Health Insurance

Financial Director Heather Woodlee explained to the Full Commission the changes in the current rate of the Health Insurance for the County Employees. Ms. Woodlee stated, "There would need to be a budget amendment by the end of the fiscal year but not at this time." The current EHB plans and the renewal rates have increased. The County's base plan has 14 of the 17 enrollments that had a 13.51% increase and the buy up plan that has 3 enrollments is getting a 22.94% increase. Based off the current enrollment numbers, that is an annual overall increase of \$31,246.68. The 2<sup>nd</sup> attachment is the total cost worksheet for 2026, following the same methodology used in 2025, with the overall breakdown of the monthly premium, Van Buren Counties contributions, and the enrolled employee's monthly contribution. The affordability percentage that is required per the ACA is going from 9.02% to 9.96% for 2026, which allows Van Buren to charge up to \$187.75 monthly (based off \$14.50/hr.) in the \$67k and down salary range and \$556.10 in the \$67k and up salary range, which was rounded down to \$550 like we did for this year. Based off the current enrollment numbers and the increase in monthly payroll deductions, the annual increase to Van Buren County is approximately \$23, 963.00.

The dental and vision is renewing as flat with no change. The tow medical plans are considered EHB plans. Van Buren is "grandfathered" in with these type of plans. Any change at all would result in the loss of the "grandfathered" states. The significance of the EHB plans are that they are "community rated" and not individually underwritten on the group level. The EHB status gives a group a level of protection in bad claim years and/or having high cost claimants. After discussion on this matter Terry Hickey made a motion, seconded by Michael Chandler to approve this plan as presented.
